

RESOLUTION NO. 03092026

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES IN THE
MAY 2, 2026 GENERAL CITY ELECTION, ELECTED TO OFFICE AND
CANCELLING THE ELECTION**

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2026, the City Council of the City of Lorenzo called for the general municipal election to be held on May 2, 2026 with early voting to be conducted from April 20, 2026 and ending April 28, 2026, for the purpose of electing the following officials:

MAYOR
ALDERMAN WARD #2
ALDERMAN WARD #4

WHEREAS, the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy have passed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Election Code §2.052 the city secretary has certified in writing that no person has made a declaration of write-in candidacy, and that each candidate on the ballot is unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Election Code Section 2.053(a), the City Council of the City of Lorenzo is authorized to declare the candidates elected to office and cancel the election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORENZO:


SECTION 1. Pursuant to the authority granted in Texas Election Code § 2.053 the following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 2, 2026 general city election, are declared elected to office, and shall be issued certificates of election following the time the election would have been canvassed:

GILBERT CARRIZALES – MAYOR
CHERYL BIRDWELL – ALDERMAN WARD # 2
RHONDA CYPERT – ALDERMAN WARD # 4


